COMPUTER USE AGREEMENT ST. MARY'S SCHOOL

St. Mary's School provides a wide range of computer resources to its students for the purpose of advancing our educational mission. As a user of these computers, you are expected to review and understand the Acceptable Use Procedures. You are expected to:

1. Protect you login information from others. Do not use other users' passwords.

2. Exercise good judgment.

3. Respect school property and be responsible in the use of equipment. Do not destroy, modify, or abuse the device in any way.

4. Do not delete or add software without permission.

- 5. Do not use devices for illegal, harassing, vandalizing, inappropriate or indecent purposes.
- 6. Do not use the Internet to access or process pornographic or otherwise inappropriate material in concert with the school Internet Safety Policy. Notify an adult whenever coming across information or messages that are inappropriate.
- 7. Be ethical and courteous. Do not send hate, harassing or obscene mail, discriminatory remarks, or demonstrate other antisocial behaviors.
- 8. Do not assume that because something is on the Internet that you can copy it. Respect copyrights.

9. Do not give out any personal information over the Internet.

10. Devices and chargers must be returned to school in good condition when taken from the building.

Violation of any of the above conditions of use may be cause for disciplinary action. Violations may constitute cause for revocation of access privileges, suspension of access to school computers, other school disciplinary action, and/or appropriate legal action. If equipment is broken upon return or chargers are missing, parents will be financially responsible for replacing it to St. Mary's School.

Note: St. Mary's has in place Internet filtering software and an Internet Safety Policy in accordance with the Children's Internet Protection Act.
